The bonus: energy savings of up to 30%

Nearly 1,000 care home owners are now enjoying complete peace of mind and making big energy savings, with OTEX.

dangerous bacteria and viruses on all wash cycles, the system helps slash energy bills by using mostly cold water.

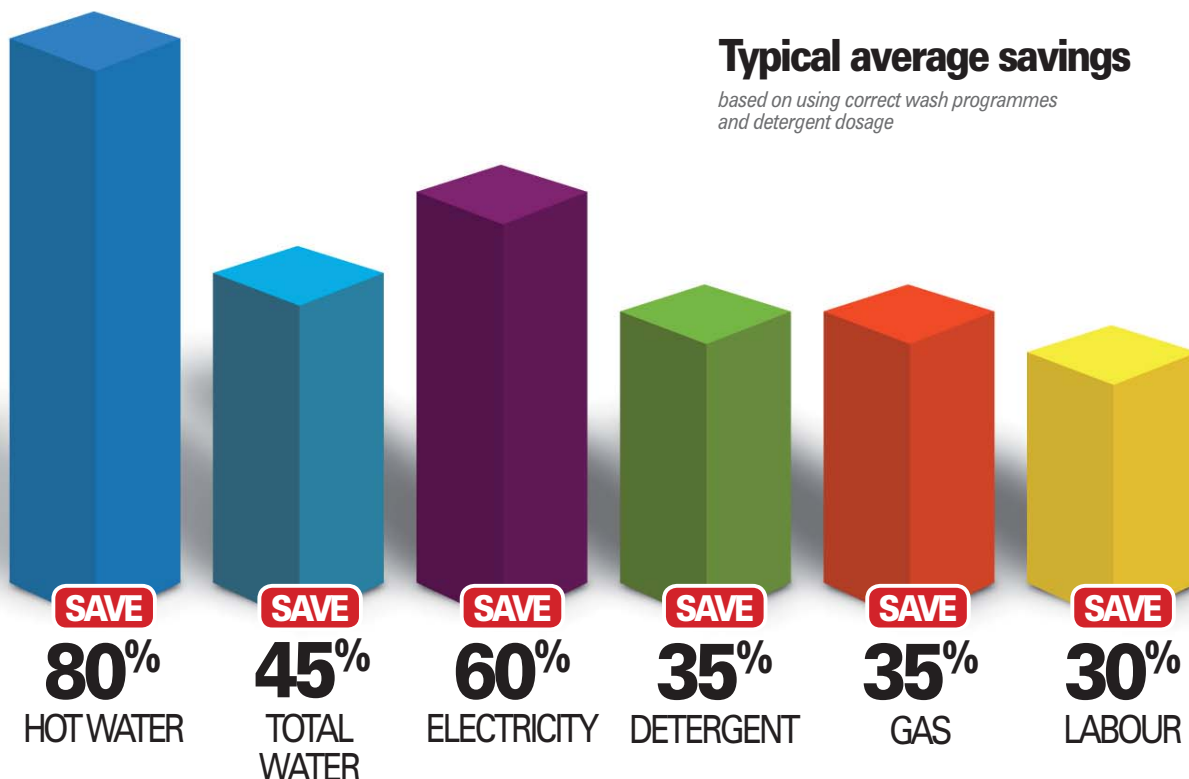
Further savings are made because of the way OTEX processes laundry. It lifts fibres, extracting more water than conventional methods and therefore reducing drying times.
